Lt. Col. Hal Jones Jr wrote his wife, Mrs. Jones of Austin, dated February Seventh from Stalag III A at Luckenwalde advising that Carter was with him PERIOD Also received telephone call from R. C. White of Monroe Louisiana who had received card from his son formerly in Oflag 64 dated March 1st stating that they about seventy five miles west of Hamburg and South of Rostock, were now at Parchim/and had traveled 350 miles on foot from Altburgund; that their probable destination was Hammelburg, Oflag 13-B, about seventy miles East of Frankfurt PERIOD Another call from New York advised Holmes Penn mother had received card dated March 8th advising they were all right and constantly pm the move PERIOD This in addition to information wired you March twenty-eighth regarding letter from YMCA and statement by Sir James Grigg, British War Secretary PERIOD It is hard to understand why the War Department or the Red Cross do not have information available as indicated by letters direct from prisoners of war referred to above PERIOD Any further information you can ascertain will be greatly appreciated. Thanks and Best regards.
