Following card dated February Seventh received this morning from Amon Junior QUOTE Am Okay and in Stalag III A, Oflag Section. Am really tired and worn out but am all right ( Several words blacked out) Saw Jones, Beasley, Batte, Henry and Wood on January 26th. They should be here soon. Poteet should be home now, Also Fablan. There are no Red Cross parcols here or anything in fact (HALF A LINE BLACKED OUT) But Don"t send clothes, just food and plenty of it (Another line blacked out) I will be home soon. Captain Herring here with mo. Address is Staleg III A, Oflag. Love to all UNQUOTE Jesse Jones and Please notify/Senater Herring PERIOD Is there not some way Red Cross can get aid to these boys? As you will note letter states no Red Cross parcels or anything in fact which means they have nothing to eat STOP Meny of the boys had no overcoats when they were marched out of Oflag 64 at Schubin notwothstanding the weather was fifteen below zero.
