DEAR DAD,

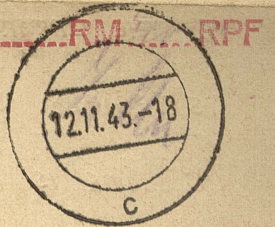
KEEPING IN GOOD HEALTH. IT IS SUNDAY AND I AM
