In this morning's mail I received word that they had been moved to PARCHIM having marched 350 miles and that their new address would probably be Pflag 64, Hammelburg, Wehkreis XIII. Last Saturday I told Capt Teel and Lt Hannon to stop off in Fort Worth and give you first hand information of the whole thing. I'm sure you have that by now.

If I get anything new I'll wire you, don't worry. I know it's easy to advise but I fully believe Amos will make it if any one does. He's strong, resourceful and intelligent.
