

Mr. Carter:

The old Board of Economic Warfare , then headed by Henry Wallace, was abolished in July after the quarrel between the Vice President and Mr. Jones.

It was supplanted by the Office of Economic Warfare , which is headed by Leo Crowley. On Sept. 26, another office was created, headed by Crowley to supplant the Office of Economic Warfare and its name is Office of Foreign Economic Administration . This now handles the duties of the old Board of Economic Warfare and the Office of Economic Warfare. Our file doesn't give the other members of the new Crowley Board. *Laughlin Currie is executive officer of the OEAA.*

I am asking Washington to supply them. I will send them to you as soon as Washington furnishes them.
