I've sent three messages to our man in Switzerland urgently requesting definite information on Amon Carter Jr. I have had no acknowledgement, despite the fact I asked for it. Other messages coming through daily so I know the man is on the job. The only conclusion I find is that the Swiss censors must be holding up my queries, for some reason. I have checked at the censorship office here and find that all of the queries were cleared. I cannot understand it as I see no reason for such messages being held up. These Swiss censors are puzzling half the time anyway. They sometimes clear messages that I would gamble would be stopped and then turn around and hold up perfectly innocent matter.

I wanted you to know that I've been trying to get some kind of word but apparently I'm stymied for the present. If anything does come through I'll message at once.

That was quite a yarn Cohn had on our young friend Van Atta, wasn't it?
