Dear Colonel Bresee:

Your letter of July 16th, enclosing correctly addressed labels with reference to Mr. Carter's son having been transferred to Oflag 64, Germany, received during Mr. Carter's absence from the city.

In compliance with your request the old labels sent from The Provost Marshall General's office are returned, herewith.

Mr. Carter was advised by the Red Cross that prison camp at Oflag IX A/Z, Germany was located about 24 miles southeast of Kassel in Rotenberg; however we are unable to locate Oflag 64 on a map we have of the German Prisoner of War Camps. If you have the location of Camp Oflag 64, will you be good enough to advise Mr. Carter here by wire, collect.
