Your letter of May 23rd received and in reply will state that the \$25.00 check which Mr. Carter sent to you was in payment for the food parcel he asked you to send to his son, Amon G. We would like to send the books he asks for so will you please not send book packages.

If you will furnish an itemized statement of the shipments made and let Mr. Carter know when the funds are depleted, he shall appreciate it very much.
