had been with my husband Colonel Henion.

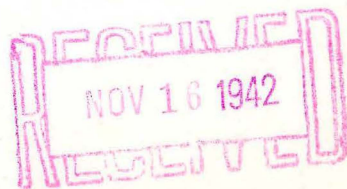
It gave my boys and me such pleasure
