Dear Amon Carter:

I have your letter of June 29 regarding your son, Lt. Amon G. Carter Jr.

The Managing Editor of The Express, Mr. Grant, tells me that an item on The Express' society page stated that your son, together with Mr. and Mrs. John Garner, was to be complimented here with a dinner party by Mr. and Mrs. Harrison Winterset Sharp Carter of Pittsburgh, Pa. This information was received by 'phone by one of the society reporters, who did not check back on the item. We have been unable to check any further information as to the persons named as giving the party. Personally, I did not see the item in question at the time. The Express previously had carried an AP story to the effect that your son was a prisoner in a German camp.

The Express will run an item stating that your son is still a war-prisoner in Germany, and a tear-sheet will be mailed to you. We are still trying to investigate the source of the information given our society reporter, and you will hear from Mr. Grant in this matter.

I regret that such a notice appeared in The Express.
