

# OFFICE MEMORANDUM

In reply to your inquiry, Lt. Amon G. Carter, Jr., is interned in prisoner of war camp Oflag 64, Germany, which was located at Schubin in the Polish Corridor about 100 miles South of Danzig. Schubin is the Polish name for the town and the Germans changed it to *(POZNAN)* Alburgund. The nearest large town is Posen about 40 miles northwest of the camp. Information has been received that the men *more than 1200 Americans* in Oflag 64 were moved from that location to Stalag No. 3-A *at* Luckenwalde, in the province of Brandenburg, Germany. This is south of Berlin and looks to be from 25 to 35 miles on our map. It is possible that they have been moved on ahead of the Russian Army advance.
