Mrs. Henry called to say that she had talked with Mrs. Emerson in Handley, whose son is interned in Oflag 64 and she received today a card from the Provost Marshal General Office, Washington, as well as from the Red Cross and the individuals that a short wave message had been received from her son, dated July 4th which said:

I am well and fine and send love to all of you

or to that effect. Also Captain Cameron of Waco sent a similar message to either his mother or wife of the same date which indicates that they were still at the same location on July 4th and everything all right.
