pneumonia. His note was brief

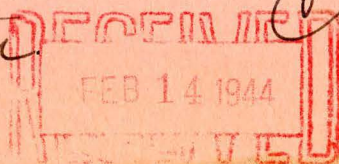
but he promised to send me
