vise that Amon Jr.'s address is:

2nd. Lt. Amon G. Carter, Jr., U. S. Army,
American Prisoner of War #1595,
Interned at Oflag 64, Germany,
Via New York, N. Y.

I am sure in communicating with him
you will make no reference to Mr. Carter's con-
nection with the newspaper or any oil activities.

As to the facts concerning his
capture, since it would entail too much description,
I am enclosing photostatic copies of two letters
from Amon Jr. and another from his Captain, which
gives both sides of the picture. When you have
gotten your information from these letters, will
you please return them to Mr. Carter.

Incidentally, the writer is keeping
all of the Kappa Sigma publications so that Amon
Jr. will have them when he returns.
