Dear Amon:

Warm thanks for your thoughtfulness in sending me tear sheets from the STAR-TELEGRAM relative to Amon, Jr., and the fact that he is now a prisoner of war in Germany.

We all were very much worried when the first news came that he was missing in action. That of course might have meant anything, and it is so extremely gratifying to have had the further word that he is all right though in the hands of our enemies. Much consolation may be found in these advices and that he is in the hands of the Germans rather than of the Japanese, though atrocities have been perpetrated by both.

We are having a meeting of our Board of Directors in Room "A", twelfth floor of the Fort Worth Club next Saturday morning. I have written Mr. Carvey about lunch for the group and I should like so much to have you also as my guest for lunch if you can work it in. I presume that we shall have lunch about 12:30 but you will be most welcome, needless to say, at whatever time you might be able to come. Please try to arrange it.
