Immediately on receipt of your letter, the Lord Mayor made further enquiries with regard to your son, and though we do not here in London get regular reports, you may be interested in up-to-date facts which the Lord Mayor has gleaned.

As you already know your son is in Oflag 9.A.Z. He was taken prisoner in Tunisia on Feb. 14th and reached the camp approximately on March 23rd. He is not wounded and is in good health. The most interesting item of information is, however, that the Camp referred to is one of the best.

The Lord Mayor desires me to send you his kind regards.
