When the print from which the magazine cut was made was received, I knew immediately that my son was not in the group. Meanwhile, we have been advised and received word direct from him that he is a prisoner of war in Germany. Although, he only has two meals a day, has lost forty pounds, his letters seem cheerful and he makes no complaints about anything.
