course as a student. - Maj. Aultman is still here, expecting an assignment to Peru. - Col. Summerall left the school and is working out of Washington. - Maj. McElroy got home three weeks ago and will probably be sent here. - Capt Frey is home, went to Ft. Sill, and is now assigned to a new Field Artillery Bn. - Its. Hancock and Groeber are on their way home. - So is Capt. McWhinney - - - so rotation is finally giving some of the boys a break. - I certainly hope that Amon Jr. joins this procession, before long. - Both you and he have certainly earned it.

Of course you know that It. Burney is Capt Burney - and has a battery. -

I'm going to write a long letter to Amon Jr. now. - I wrote the last one as a civilian so I guess it went through all right.
