I want to thank you for writing to me about my son Lt. John R. Martin, who is a prisoner of war.

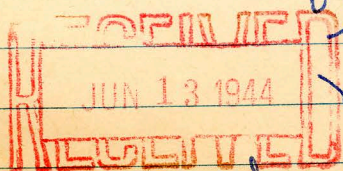
It helps a great deal to know just where he is located. I have had a letter and three cards from him since he has been at Camp Oflag 64.

He seems rather cheerful, but wants food. I have sent him one parcel of food also cigarettes, and for mail - will be certainly will get that, for I write often.
