But I wish you would please send me a set of those pictures.

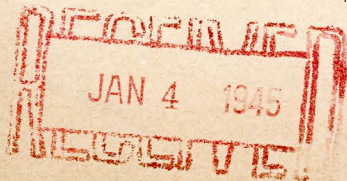
I will be glad to pay for them.

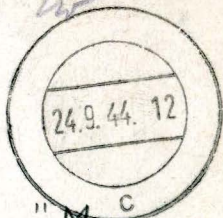
