Dear Mrs. Monroe:

In reply to your letter of March 12, permit me to advise that I have received the names of none of the boys who have been liberated from Oflag 64 by the advance of the Russian Army other than those which have appeared in the paper. There was a boy from Stephenville, Austin, Sweetwater, two from Waco and one from Fort Worth. A few of these boys have been returned to the States; however, they know nothing beyond the first night after their evacuation when they were liberated and the main body of the group marched on. However, I shall be glad to pass any information along that I may receive from time to time.
