Fort Worth Artillery Officer Unaccounted For in North Africa Area Since Feb. 14

Lt. Amon G. Carter Jr. has been missing in action since Feb. 14, his father, Amon Carter, was advised Thursday in a telegram from Major General Ulio, adjutant general. A field artillery officer with an armored division, his unit was in action around Sbeitla, Central Tunisia, on that date.

Lieutenant Carter, a graduate of Culver Military Academy, was a reserve officer and was called to active duty in July, 1941; trained at Fort Knox, Ky., and for several months prior to the landing in North Africa was stationed with the contingent of United States troops in North Ireland and England.
