

# 1,000 U. S. Prisoners Moved by Germans

WASHINGTON, Feb. 23 (AP).—The government said Friday that more than 1,000 American prisoners of war in Germany had been moved westward from Oflag 64 and Stalag 111B to Stalag 111A at Luckenwalde.

The announcement stated:

“Other Americans from Oflag 64 and Stalag Luft IV are in the vicinity of Swinemund. About one half of the Americans formerly detained at Stalag Luft III are en route to Moosburg, while the destination of the other half is reported to be Nurnberg. A small number of American officers from Stalag Luft III were moved to Stalag IIIA at Luckenwalde.

“Pending notification to the contrary, relatives and friends are urged to continue to address mail to individual prisoners of war to their last known addresses.”
