Dear Mrs. Pauck:

Inasmuch as Mr. Carter has not returned to this country, I am taking the liberty of acknowledging your letter of May 10 seeking information about your husband, 1st Sgt. Karl F. Pauck who was a prisoner of war in camp Stalag 3 B.

Mr. Carter's son was moved from Oflag 64 in Poland to Stalag III A at Luckenwalde and even though they were in the same Battery and captured in the same action, I am quite sure he has not been interned in the same prisoner of war camp and would probably be unable to give you any information; however, when he returns to this country the matter shall be brought to his attention and you may rest assured that he will be glad to pass along any information he may have.
