This is merely to acknowledge your letter of March 10 and to advise that other than a card dated January 4, nothing more has been heard about or from Amon Junior. Every few days word is received that some member of Oflag 64 has been liberated and reached the United States Military Mission in Moscow; however, I have been unable to ascertain the list either of those liberated or those not liberated and I am advised that the War Department expects to have the list from day to day. Naturally, any information obtained shall be passed along to you with pleasure. Meanwhile, keep your courage and keep hoping and praying that everything will turn out all right.
