I was in Cherbourg, France last week and met a very interesting Englishman who asked me to do a favor for him. First he asked if I knew anyone in Ft Worth who knew Mr. Amon Carter. When I said that you did he asked me to write you and ask if you wouldn't tell him sometime how much he appreciates his Carter Stetson. He is very happy with the hat and has written Mr. Carter how he appreciates it but is afraid that the letter may never have reached him. He said that Elliot Roosevelt and another man by the name of Peterson from Ft. Worth presented the hat to him in front of a large crowd. The name and address is as follows:
