Dear Captain Jaccard:

Mr. Carter left Tuesday night to return to the 'States and asked that I write to you, to inquire if you might obtain for him another leather cigaret case -- one in the \$15 size. A money order for that amount is enclosed.

He said if you had not been able to ship the others as yet, he would appreciate it if you could have this smaller box wrapped separately, addressed to Maj. C. A. Schaubel, HQ ETOUSA, APO 887. In the event that package is enclosed with the others, Major Schaubel lives in the Hotel Majestic in Paris.

Mr. Carter said he realized that this is an imposition on your good nature, but he said he was confident you would understand that "It is difficult to stop when you start trying to remember your friends."

"Please tell Captain Jaccard," he said, "that when he comes back to the 'States, I'll be delighted to have him bring his wife down to Fort Worth for a visit and I'll try to even the score with him for his hospitality in Italy."
