Lt. Amon Carter Jr. Is
Safe, Americans Learn

EAST OF THE ELBE WITH
THE RUSSIAN ARMIES, May 2—
AP—Three released American pris-
oners of war from Luckenwalde
reported today that a Fort Worth
publisher's son, Lt. Amon G. Car-
ter, was alive and well and had
been liberated by the Russian ad-
vance.

"Carter was in charge of distrib-
uting Red Cross parcels, and was
staying in the Luckenwalde camp
in compliance with senior Amer-
ican officer's order that prisoners
stay there until arrangements are
made for them," said Lt. Henry N.
Crellin, Springfield, Ohio.
