**Talks To Ladonia Boy
Prisoner Of War**

Amos Carter, publisher of the Fort Worth Star-Telegram, was one of the newspapermen who recently went to Europe to check atrocities committed by the Germans on allied prisoners of war. He also visited the German prison camps—where he talked to dozens of Texans who had been liberated from German prisons, according to press dispatches from Europe. The list of names of Texans was quite a long one, and among whom was a Ladonia boy: Pvt. Raymond Crews, son of Mr. and Mrs. Walter Crews who live north of Ladonia. Mr. Carter stated that most of the men from Texas were in good condition both physically and spiritually and preparations were being made to bring the men home as quickly as possible.
