**Son of Fort Worth
Publisher Is Freed** 90

WITH U. S. NINTH ARMY, Germany — (UP) — Lieutenant Amon Carter, Junior, son of the publisher of the Fort Worth Texas Star-Telegram, has been liberated from the German prison camp at Luckenwald by Ninth army troops.

His father is one of the group of American publishers and editors who are touring German prison camps to investigate atrocities.

Carter, who had not yet seen his father in Europe. asked United Press War Correspondent Robert Vermillion to notify his father he was in good health.
