Fort Worth Editor's Son Is Liberated

WITH U. S. NINTH ARMY, Germany, May 5 (UP) Lt. Amon Carter Jr., son of the publisher of the Fort Worth (Tex.) Star-Telegram, has been liberated from the German prison camp at Luckenwald by Ninth Army troops.

His father is one of the group of American publishers and editors who are touring German prison camps to investigate atrocities.

Carter, who had not yet seen his father in Europe, asked United Press Correspondent Robert Vermillion to notify his father he was in good health.
