Amon G. Carter Sr. Meets Soldier Son In Germany *90*

According to widely published news dispatches, Amon G. Carter Sr., Fort Worth publisher and extensive oil operator in the Kermit area, met his son, Amon G. Carter Jr., in Germany after his liberation as a prisoner of war by the Eighty-Third Division of the American Army.

Lt. Richard E. Dwelle, co-owner with Nev H. Williams of The Winkler County News, has been with the Eighty-Third Division during its march through Germany. Lieutenant Dwelle is an infantry officer and was fighting from foxholes in Germany as late as April 21, 1945. It is quite possible Mr. Carter and Lieutenant Dwelle met in Germany.

Lieutenant Dwelle expects to visit his wife and daughter in Dallas soon.
