Balcony In Rome 90

ROME, May 13 (AP).—Undersecretary of War Patterson said Sunday the War department hoped to salvage 70 per cent of the army equipmnt in Europe for use in the Pacific war.

Patterson and Amon G. Carter, publisher of the Fort Worth (Texas) Star-Telegram, toured Rome's scenic spots after flying here from northern Italy, then left by plane for Paris.

Carter stood on Mussolini's balcony overlooking Rome's Piazza Venezia and gave a big cheer for Texas.
