Am today in receipt of a letter from my brother, Lt. Teddy Roggen, who is interned at Oflag 64, advising us that if we will contact you; you can furnish information in speeding mail to him. Up to date we have sent all of them by air and he advises in his letter written January 10, to date he has had no word from us. We are aware of the fact that it takes at least four months for mail to be reached; and cannot understand what he may be speaking of. Any information will be greatly appreciated.

In all of his letters he mentions Amon and John Jones and that the situation is well in hand, that they receive their weekly Red Cross package which I am sure helps matters on.

Any assistance will be most genuinely appreciated,
