Dear Mrs. Saikin:

In reply to your letter of March 27, may I advise that my last letter from Amon Junior was dated January 4; however, his mother who lives in New York received a card this morning dated February 7 in which he advised that he was very tired and was anxious to come home, not to send anything but food and that he was at Stalag III A at Luckenwalde.

Mrs. Jones of Austin had a letter from her husband, Lt. Col. Hal Jones Jr. dated February 7 in which he advised that he was at Luckenwalde and a Mr. White of Monroe, Louisiana received a card dated March 1 from his son who said he was at Parchim and thought his probable destination would be Hammelburg. I am sorry not to be able to give you more information, but it would seem from the above communications that these boys in Oflag 64 have been split up.
