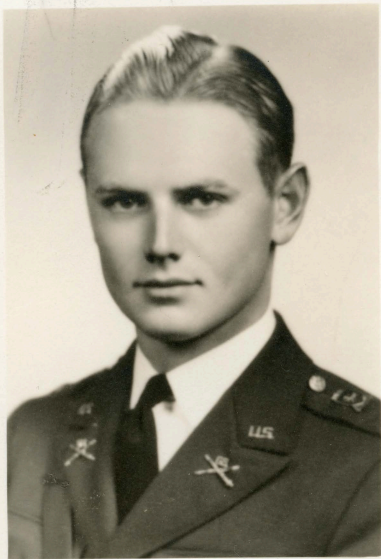
Mrs. Romeiser joins me in wishing yourself and family good health and trusting that in due time you will have your son with you again so that your dreams for his future will be fully realized.
