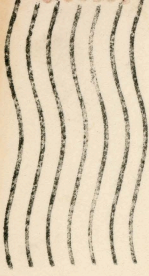
I wish to express my deep appreciation of the generous offer made by you and Mr. Rogers, to the citizenship of Waco for its charity and unemployment relief.
