We have a 293 acre Municipal airport which would make it possible for Mr. Rogers to come to Tyler in his plane and to carry out the same program here as will be followed in other cities.


We assure you that it is our sincere desire to have Mr. Rogers visit us and we shall appreciate your efforts to see that Tyler is included in his itinerary.
