## \$1818 TO NEAR BY COUNTIES

### Tom Green Receives \$4535 From Rogers' Fund

Of the total of \$6353 taken in by Will Rogers at his West Texas charity benefit, \$1818 goes to surrounding counties. Every community or county that purchased as much as \$50 worth of tickets receives back every cent spent for the tickets, for its local relief.

Checks were signed today by Charles W. Hobbs, general chairman and treasurer of the fund, to the following counties and communities who purchased more than \$50 worth of tickets:


Dear Sir:
