Your letter has been received making inquiry concerning pictures taken in Oflag 64 Germany where your husband, Lt. Leonard W. Spence is interned as a prisoner of war. Mr. Carter is out of the city at the present time, however, I am taking the liberty of sending a set of these pictures along to you which you may keep, as well as a copy of the letter from Lt. Meadows, who sent the pictures to Mr. Carter.

For fear you might not have seen the article, I am enclosing a clipping from the Sunday Star-Telegram covering an interview with Colonel Drake, the senior officer at Oflag 64, who has recently been repatriated and gives information that all of us are interested in knowing. I hope that your husband is in these pictures and that you hear from him with some degree of regularity. Our last letter from Amon Junior was dated August 26.
