Dear Mr. Carter:

I received a card yesterday from Amon Jr written on Dec 20th. and I thought you might like to know that I have heard from him. From the tone of his letters he seems to be in very good spirits. He also mentioned that he had sent you some pictures of the gang, and that you might send me a set of them. I would be more than glad to have a set of these pictures. Maybe before long now Germany will be defeated and our boys who are prisoners will be freed. It will really be a happy day when we can see them again. I talked with Mrs McPheters (wife of Col McPheters) a few days ago and she brought me up to date on alot of the boys in the 91st F.A who

had been rotated, captured, killed etc. Col McPheters took command of The 91st FA. right after Amon was captured. He was later killed at Anzio in sort of a freak mishap.

Since my last letter to you, I have acquired a wife and have been relieved from The service. My wife was a RED CROSS worker at WINTER GEN. HOSP. Do to my disability, I was declared unfit for active military service, so we have come back to Indianapolis to make our home. I am giving my Dad a helping hand with The DRUG STORE.

I would appreciate hearing from you soon, and undoubtedly you have more news about Amon. If you can send The pictures he mentioned, I would like to have them. Heres' hopin' Amon will be back soon.
