In Mr. Carter's absence from the country permit the writer to advise that our information is to the effect that all of those interned at Stalag III-A at Luckenwalde were liberated by the Russians and negotiations are being made to return these boys to military control of the Allies or to ship them direct to this country. So, in all probability, your son will be returning or you will hear from him within a short time.

Mr. Carter's son reached this country a couple of days ago although he has not reached home as yet and we do not know when to expect him. If he should know anything about your son, we shall be glad to pass the information along.
