Dear Mr. Carter

Your letter came while I was visiting at Ft. Sill so I am late answering it.

I was happy to get so recent news from the camp as the last letter I had from Major Swindler was written Jan. 7th. I was glad to learn that they were moved without accident.

I had received notice that my husband was a prisoner on Jan. 2nd after he had been missing for 3 months. Of course you know how glad we were to get that news. I had 7 letters written a week apart, the last one arriving last Monday. He says that he is well but has lost nearly 30 pounds which makes me realize that the food situation is serious.

With the Russians approaching Berlin as they are now I wonder if they will move them again and would appreciate any information you may get on that.

Thank you so much for your information and your kindness in writing us.
