Please accept my sincere thanks for your telegram of July 31st, advising that the information received by your office indicated that Oflag 21 B had been renumbered Oflag 64 and that it is in vicinity of Schubin Polish Corridor.

Meantime, we received a card written by Amon Junior July 1st which arrived here July 31st and the address had been changed from something to Oflag 64. He said he was sleeping under three blankets and hated to think what the winter would be like - this indicates that he is located as you advised.

You have been exceedingly considerate and cooperative in giving me information concerning my son, Amon Junior, and I am most grateful for your sympathetic understanding of my anxiety concerning him.
