Dear Sam:

I hope you can find some way of bring<sup>ing</sup> up H. R. 2319 concerning the unification of the armed forces. This bill, as I am sure you already know, is of extreme importance and should be able to be voted on without further delay. Understand some Congressman is unnecessarily delaying the bill, asking for further information which would necessitate considerable research and delay, and be the means of killing the bill in this manner, at least for the present time.

It looks like our country will never wake up to the realization of necessary preparedness, compulsory military training and adequate preparedness to avoid future wars. The next war will, no doubt, have to be fought with the planes, army equipment and organizations we have in effect at the time hostilities commence. Thus preparedness may be the means of not only saving hundreds of thousands of lives, as well as avoiding the destruction of our country. I hope you can do something to help bring this bill up for action.
