Dear Mrs. Deakins:

I am enclosing the negative of the picture and am happy to let you use it. In fact, I had planned all the time to send you a print or the negative, but someone has been using it all the time since I received it. I received the pictures Monday. Please feel free to keep the negative as long as you need to. Mrs. Warren, my mother-in-law, just returned the negative to me today.

This morning I received a letter from Chester dated July 17. He seems to be doing fine. He said that all the boys were in good spirits and that he didn't think that it would be long until they could come home. He also said that he weighed about 160 which is more than he weighed when he was captured. This is the latest news that I have received. I do hope that you all are hearing from Amon Jr. regularly. I write Chester every day and he said that he had had no mail in five weeks but that the other prisoners were still getting mail all the time. I can't understand why he is not getting his, but he will probably get several letters at one time when he does hear.
