about him. The last we have heard  
from him was a letter written on  
Dec. 27. That's a mighty long time

so many have died of starvation & others  
have frozen we are afraid that he is  
one of the many.

I am so happy for you, that your son  
will get home safely. I saw in last  
night's Toronto Chronicle where he is in  
Paris now.

I hope you can understand the way we  
feel & I'm sure you can.
