You will simply be making the trip as a passenger over a new line which you will no doubt patronize many times in the future STOP This would be a nice wedding present for our old friend C. R. Smith as he telephoned asking me to extend the invitation to you STOP You can have a nice visit with Betty and Mary and be back home in three or four days. This will be the first continuous direct service Los Angeles has had to Washington and Boston and I hope you will join me. Best regards.
