Bodies of Rogers Post in California Late Monday

**AMON G. CARTER PASSENGER
ON SHIP CARRYING BODIES
TO LOS ANGELES**

LOS ANGELES, Aug. 19.—The bodies of Will Rogers, 56, actor, humorist, and Wiley Post, 35, famous aviator, arrived in Los Angeles from Alaska late this afternoon.

Joe Crosson, famed arctic flyer, was at the controls of the plane that carried the bodies from Point Barrow to Seattle. William Winston, Texas airman, was the aviator in charge of the trip from Seattle to Los Angeles.

Amon G. Carter, Fort Worth publisher, and a long time friend of the Rogers family, and Col. Clarence Young, Pacific Coast Manager of Pan-American Airways, were on the big silver plane that carried the bodies.

The body of Wiley Post will be sent by plane to Oklahoma City for burial.

Funeral services for Will Rogers will be held in Los Angeles on Thursday. The body will be placed in a tomb in a Los Angeles cemetery.
