From the minutes of the City Council of the City of Fort Worth, Texas, Aug. 21, 1935:

Councilman Harrell called to the attention of the Council the funeral of Will Rogers to be held Thursday, Aug. 22, 1935, and made a motion, which was seconded by Councilman Murphy, that the flags on the city hall and other public buildings be flown at half-mast; also, that the Mayor, City Manager, and Legal Department prepare a suitable resolution for adoption with reference to Mr. Rogers, and further, that it be suggested to officials of the Fat Stock Show that should the Centennial bond election carry and buildings be constructed, that a protion of the institution be designated as a memorial to Will Rogers because of his interest in livestock.

The above motion was voted without dissent.
